Venues For Group Events

Ajuda Nacional Palace *Banquet capacity 300* Located between Monsanto Park and Belém, this neoclassic building of the early 19th century was the last permanent residence of the Portuguese Royal family.

Rocha Conde de Óbidos Palace *Banquet capacity 280* Head office of the Portuguese Red Cross, this Palace dates from the 16th century but was reconstructed at the end of the 18th Century.

Coach Museum *Banquet capacity Main Hall 200* The coach museum is housed in the former royal riding school situated next to the President's official residence in the Belém area. The collection of antique coaches from different centuries found here is considered one of the best in the world.

Places Of Interest

Alfama / Castelo / Mouraria The oldest part crowned by the St. Jorges Castle with the best view over the city.

The Baixa / Chiado The very heart of Lisboa with pedestrian shopping area and beautiful squares.

The Bairro Alto / Santos With designer boutiques, restaurants, bars and nightspots.

Belém The monumental part with the UNESCO world heritage sites, the Jeronimus monastery and Torre de Belém (Belém Tower).

Avenida Da Liberdade Just north of Rossio, discover Avenida da Liberdade, which in the 19th century, was the favorite promenade for the Lisbon élite. Today, the Avenida is home to exclusive international boutiques to tempt and inspire.

Parque das Nações (Nations Park) Built to host the world EXPO 98. Here you will find ultra modern architecture in the fantastic “Oceanario” as well as FIL (Lisboa International Fair), Pavilhão Atlantico, our biggest meetings and events facilities and Casino Lisboa.

Setúbal / Tróia The Costa Azul has a wide natural diversity of landscapes and environments, favored by the presence of the sea. This is a wonderful region to discover. It has a wealth of natural and cultural attractions. There's always the Sea, the Nature and the Golf.

Cascais / Estoril is ripe for discovery. Romantic, cosmopolitan, packed with entertainment and boasting a unique character, Estoril is where Lisbon meets the sea. Considered to be the Portuguese Riviera, Estoril and Cascais are full of glamour and charisma.
